ALMS Announcement (7 March 2013) - Attention SSD-I Students: By direction of the Institute of Non-Commissioned Officer Professional Development (NCOPD), a letter of instruction (LOI) has been added to the course materials. The LOI is a pre-requisite for completion. If you are taking the course and find that you do not have launch buttons for lessons, you will need to find the LOI on the ALMS Enrollments page and launch it. After reading and closing it, you should be able to proceed in the course. A Map Reading lesson has also been added at the end of Module 4. This lesson will need to be completed before you will be able to access the Module 4 Exam. In other cases a separate Module 4a has been added containing the Map Reading lesson. This Module will need to be completed before you will be able to access the Module 4 Exam.

The ALMS is an integral component of the <u>Army Distributed Learning System (DLS)</u>, and is the Army's automated system for individual training management. The ALMS delivers training to soldiers and DA civilians, manages training information, provides training collaboration, scheduling, and career planning capabilities in both resident and non-resident training environments.
