A THOROUGH BACKGROUND CHECK IS CONDUCTED PRIOR TO EMPLOYMENT

EMPLOYEES IN THE MILITARY DEPARTMENT UNCLASSIFIED SERVICE, PERMANENT OR TEMPORARY, ARE EMPLOYED "AT WILL" AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO TERMINATION OR EXPIRATION OF APPOINTMENT, WITH OR WITHOUT CAUSE.

1. **AREA OF CONSIDERATION:** (1) Active Louisiana National Guard Members; (2) Retired National Guard Members and Retired Active Military Soldiers; (3) those eligible for Louisiana State Guard Membership.

2. **QUALIFICATIONS:** (In addition to below, see application procedures).

a. **SPECIFIC:** Must have 12 months of experience or 6 months experience and have attended a range operation and maintenance course. Additionally, must have: Experience which required the establishment of priorities to meet deadlines. Experience with Training Aids, Devices, Simulators, and Simulations (TADSS) equipment. Experience that provided knowledge of various lines of work performed by this function (Target Technician). Experience in adapting existing equipment and techniques to new situations. Experience in reading and applying schematics and wiring diagrams to assigned tasks. Experience in conducting classes/training scenarios. Must have the ability to lift 25 pounds unassisted, including above the shoulder. Must be comfortable working near firearms and on firing ranges.

b. **GENERAL:** Must have a valid Driver's License, Social Security Card and Birth Certificate. Must qualify to obtain a CAC Card. Ability to work and communicate effectively with peers, superiors and subordinates. Travel may be required. Must be available to report to duty during emergency or disaster situations.

c. **OTHER REQUIREMENTS:** The Military Department is a substance abuse and drug free workplace. In accordance with the Military Department Drug Testing Policy, all new employees are subject to mandatory drug testing. Thereafter, all employees are subject to random drug testing. Must meet physical requirements to perform functions of the position. Ability to work and communicate effectively with agency personnel and the public.

3. CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT: By submitting an application for employment with the Military Department, the applicant agrees to the following conditions of employment:

a. Salary is paid by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) / Direct Deposit Only. A checking or savings account is required for employment.

b. Applicants who are active members of the Louisiana National Guard or uniformed members of the Louisiana State Guard must wear the appropriate military uniform and meet prescribed military grooming standards.

4. POSITION DESCRIPTION: Assists in establishing work priorities and conducts maintenance, troubleshoots, repair and replace 250 Stationary Infantry Target (SIT) mechanisms. Automated Ranges responsibilities include: Inspections, tests, services, adjustments, alignments, calibrations, installation, repairs, replacements, reconditioning, troubleshooting, field-testing and/or shop testing target mechanisms and hit sensor devices. Replaces/repairs defective hardware and parts such as relays, switches, assemblies, cables, target elevating mechanisms, hydraulic cylinders, piping, valves, pumps, junction boxes, solenoids, electric motors, rectifiers, diodes, transformers, rheostats, transistors, resistors, capacitors, thermal panels and other components. Fabricates and repairs electrical power/data cables, hit sensor cable assemblies, hard-wire control power distribution/switch devices, etc. Performs routine flatwork welding repairs to metal mechanical target mounting ~~boxes~~ Assists in the programming of new range systems and system upgrades. Must attend periodic Range Technician Courses to maintain proficiency of automation systems and programs. On Non-Automated Ranges responsibilities include: building target frames, adding coreplast, installing targets on ranges, maintaining sandbags, foxholes, berms, and erosion control structures. On all ranges will assist in the controlled access to training facilities and perform other related functions including closing and securing the facilities as needed. Range maintenance includes applying various pesticides and herbicides to target emplacement areas and the use of electrical tools such as drills, saws, and sanders in order to maintain and provide basic repair of ranges and range equipment. Report to work on time, dress IAW SMD SOP, personal hygiene IAW SMD SOP, and follow all the regulations and SOPs for the area working in. Completion of SHARP training and fosters sexual harassment free environment. Complete all LMD training required annually. Performs other duties as assigned.

5. APPLICATION PROCEDURES: All Applicants must complete a LANG-LMD-H Form 10 (State Application) and attach a legible copy of their Official Birth Certificate, Driver's License and Social Security Card.
