1. AREA OF CONSIDERATION: (1) Active Louisiana National Guard Members; (2) Retired National Guard Members and Retired Military Members; (3) those eligible for Louisiana State Guard Membership.

2. QUALIFICATIONS: (In addition to below, see application procedures).

a. **SPECIFIC:** Plumber license is desirable. Must be able to perform the manual labor tasks associated with maintenance and repair of post plumbing, sewer and natural gas system. Must be able to read blueprints. Must be able to determine scopes of work, material, labor and equipment required from verbal instructions or work orders.

b. **GENERAL:** Must have a valid Driver's License, Social Security Card and Birth Certificate. Must qualify to obtain a Common Access Card (CAC) Card. Travel may be required. Must be available to report to duty during emergency or disaster situations. Must have the ability to work and communicate effectively with agency personnel, peers, superiors, subordinates and the public.

c. **OTHER REQUIREMENTS:** The LA Military Department is a substance abuse and drug free workplace. In accordance with the Military Department Drug Testing Policy, all new employees are subject to mandatory drug testing. Thereafter, all employees are subject to random drug testing. Must meet physical requirements to perform functions of the position. Must attend/complete all LMD annual training and other training required for the position. Must adhere to the Code of Ethics and foster a Sexual Harassment-Free Environment.

3. **CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:** By submitting an application for employment with the Military Department, the applicant agrees to the following conditions of employment:

a. Salary is paid by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) / Direct Deposit Only. A checking or savings account is required for employment.

b. The successful applicant will be required to join the Louisiana State Guard as a condition of employment. Service in the Louisiana State Guard does not require the applicant to perform military training, periodic inactive duty (monthly drills), nor does it require deployment outside of the State of Louisiana. The applicant can expect that service in the Louisiana State Guard to be substantially the same as normal State Government working conditions.

4. **POSITION DESCRIPTION:** Installs, alters, maintains and repairs plumbing fixtures and equipment such as water lines, sewerage lines, gas lines, steam lines, gas heaters, hot water heaters, water fountains and steam cookers. Repairs and replaces worn plumbing fixtures. Repairs leaking faucets and opens clogged drains. Inspects, repairs and make adjustments to piping and tubing connected to steam pumps and air compressors, water pumps and heaters. Directs and trains apprentice helpers. Must continue to work towards a Journeyman Plumbing certification. Must be able to weld to join all types of plumbing and fabricate brackets from aging infrastructure. Must be able to use cutting torches and grinders to assist Installation Welder in numerous tasks and repairs. Must maintain and wear all safety related equipment and/or report any violations or deficiencies. Must use energy conservation measures and ensure that these measures are taken daily before leaving the job site. Maintain accountability of all equipment and/or ensure data cards are up to date. Maintain and practice good environmental protection measures. Must respond to tenant requests with professionalism and courtesy. Must inform the supervisor of all telephone and address changes. Perform other duties as assigned.

5. APPLICATION PROCEDURES: All Applicants must complete a LANG-LMD-H Form 10 (State Application) and attach a legible copy of their Official Birth Certificate, Driver's License and Social Security Card.
