- 1. **AREA OF CONSIDERATION:** (1) Active Louisiana National Guard Members; (2) Retired National Guard Members and Retired Military Members; (3) those eligible for Louisiana State Guard Membership.
- 2. **QUALIFICATIONS:** (In addition to below, see application procedures).
- a. **SPECIFIC:** Must be able to work independently to meet established deadlines and objectives. Ability to work with general guidance to meet objectives. Must have a working knowledge of general operations procedures and maintenance safety directives.
- b. **GENERAL:** Must have a valid Driver's License, Social Security Card and Birth Certificate. Must qualify to obtain a Common Access Card (CAC) Card. Travel may be required. Must be available to report to duty during emergency or disaster situations. Must have the ability to work and communicate effectively with agency personnel, peers, superiors, subordinates and the public.
- c. **OTHER REQUIREMENTS:** The LA Military Department is a substance abuse and drug free workplace. In accordance with the Military Department Drug Testing Policy, all new employees are subject to mandatory drug testing. Thereafter, all employees are subject to random drug testing. Must meet physical requirements to perform functions of the position. Must attend/complete all LMD annual training and other training required for the position. Must adhere to the Code of Ethics and foster a Sexual Harassment-Free Environment.
- 3. **CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:** By submitting an application for employment with the Military Department, the applicant agrees to the following conditions of employment:
- a. Salary is paid by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) / Direct Deposit Only. A checking or savings account is required for employment.

- b. The successful applicant will be required to join the Louisiana State Guard as a condition of employment. Service in the Louisiana State Guard does not require the applicant to perform military training, periodic inactive duty (monthly drills), nor does it require deployment outside of the State of Louisiana. The applicant can expect that service in the Louisiana State Guard to be substantially the same as normal State Government working conditions.
- 4. **POSITION DESCRIPTION:** Serves as Utilities Technician under the general supervision of the Utilities Superintendent. Performs tasks associated with the support of Facility Engineer, maintenance of equipment and other maintenance related tasks AC, electrical and powerhouse, etc. Physically perform manual labor as needed with minimum supervision. Performs a variety of Facility Engineer duties in support of the overall Installation maintenance and repair workload. Support the Gillis W. Long Center during State emergencies and projects. Maintain, repairs and alter the following equipment: Air conditioning units, window units, walk-in coolers, deep freezer units (commercial and domestic), domestic refrigerators, forces air heating units, ovens, refrigerators, stove and water cooler. Perform assignments orally or written work requested with instructions as to how the work is to be accomplished. Perform diagnostic and testing and major overhaul of equipment. Install duct work, insulation of refrigerator lines and other equipment when necessary. Maintain and repair heating ventilating, air conditioning refrigerator equipment in buildings or complexes requiring total HVAC capacity of 20 tons or more. Perform preventative maintenance duties on motors. Perform other duties as assigned.
