Passing the ACFT is a critical component. of your readiness as a Soldier. Service members who do not pass the ACFT in April may lose tuition exemption or their enlistment bonus.

- October 1– the monthly stipend rate for Ch. 1606 goes up to \$439 per month for students who are enrolled full time in school.
- In order to use any GI Bill benefits, you must apply for your Certificate of Eligibility (COE) by visiting www.va.gov and click on "Apply for Education benefits".

- The new website for Federal Tuition Assistance (FTA) and Credentialing Assistance (CA) is: www.armyignited.army.mil
- FTA pays \$4,000 per year for classes towards Associates, Bachelor's or Master's degrees, with a per-class cap of \$750. You may also use FTA one time to pay for an Academic Certificate. Visit www.armyignited.army.mil today to learn more, or call our office!

Download your Joint Services Transcript to receive college credits!

You may not know this, but you have earned college credits by attending military training.
Visit https://jst.doded.mil/jst/ today to download your Joint Services Transcript. You can then turn it in to the school you are attending and they will tell you which college classes you will be exempt from since you've already completed the training.
