## POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Provides grounds, facility, and range maintenance support for the Camp Beauregard training complex. Ensures training areas, buildings, and equipment are properly maintained, safe, and available for use by military units and other authorized organizations. Operates and maintains grounds keeping equipment used to maintain training areas and facilities. Equipment includes rotary mowers (14 -30 horsepower), small riding and push mowers, and string trimmers. Performs routine landscaping tasks including mowing, trimming vegetation, maintaining trees, shrubs, and flower beds, and general grounds upkeep. Maintains and services assigned equipment by checking fuel levels, oil, and operating fluids and performing basic preventive maintenance. Cleans and properly stores equipment after use. Performs general maintenance and cleaning of buildings and surrounding areas including washing exterior walls, windows, sidewalks, steps, and fixtures using pressure washers or similar equipment. Serves as the Grounds and Buildings representative for the Range Maintenance Team at the Brushy Road training area. Responsible for maintaining security and oversight of approximately 17 structures across a 10-acre site. Conducts routine inspections of facilities and identifies repair requirements. Submits work order requests and coordinates with facility engineers and contractors when maintenance or construction work is required. Supports maintenance of the 12,500-acre training complex by inspecting maneuver trails, landing zones, bivouac areas, staging sites, and other training locations. Conducts routine and post-severe weather inspections to identify hazards or damage affecting training operations. Serves as the Range Maintenance representative within the Range Facility Management Support System (RFMSS) to monitor and ensure training areas are prepared for scheduled use. Provides information and assistance to units regarding availability and conditions of training resources including maneuver areas, dig sites, staging areas, and bivouac locations. Reports safety hazards, equipment deficiencies, environmental concerns, and unexploded ordnance (UXO) hazards to supervisors. Coordinates with Louisiana Department of Wildlife and Fisheries for removal of feral hogs from training areas when required. Assists state forestry personnel with land management activities such as timber maintenance and prescribed burns. Must be available to report for duty during state or federal emergencies. Maintains records related to equipment maintenance, fuel usage, and supply levels. Provides input to supervisors regarding long-range maintenance planning for range facilities and infrastructure. May assist in training assigned personnel in safe operation of equipment and daily work activities. Complies with all Louisiana Military Department and State Military Department policies and regulations.

## **POSITION QUALIFICATIONS:**

Knowledge of range operations procedures and applicable policies. Experience operating and maintaining light and heavy equipment used for grounds and facility maintenance. Knowledge of applicable safety laws, regulations, and safe equipment operation practices. Ability to perform physical tasks including lifting up to 25 pounds unassisted, including overhead lifting. Possession of a valid Louisiana driver's license and ability to complete State Employee Driver Training. Ability to work safely in environments where firearms are present, including active firing ranges.

## **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:**

- Must have a valid Driver's License, Social Security Card and Birth Certificate.
- Must qualify to obtain a Department of Defense Common Access Card (CAC) Card.
- Must be available to report to duty during emergency or disaster situations.  
Other periodic travel may be required.
- Must meet physical requirements to perform functions of the position.
- Must attend/complete all Louisiana Military Department (LMD) annual training and other training required for the position.
- Must adhere to the Code of Ethics and foster a Sexual Harassment-Free Environment.

**CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:** By submitting an application for employment with the Military Department, the applicant agrees to the following conditions of employment:

- All LMD positions require in-office attendance. This is not a remote position.
- Salary is paid by Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) / Direct Deposit Only. A checking or savings account is required for employment.
- For positions requiring computer/email access selected applicant must qualify to obtain a Department of Defense Common Access Card (CAC) Card and maintain eligibility
- LMD is a substance abuse and drug free workplace. The selected applicant must pass a pre-employment background investigation and pre-employment drug test. Thereafter, all employees are subject to random drug testing.
- To become an employee of the LMD you must be a current member of the Louisiana National Guard or eligible for membership in the Louisiana State Guard.
- The selected applicant must pass a pre-employment criminal background investigation prior to employment.

**APPLICATION PROCEDURES:** All Applicants must complete a LANG-LMD-H Form 10 (State Application) and attach a legible copy of their Official Birth Certificate, Driver's License and Social Security Card. Resumes are optional and will not be accepted unless they are submitted with the LANG-LMD-H Form 10 (State Application).
