Must be a current on-board AGR in the State of LA within the grade(s) of E6 and E7.

AREA OF CONSIDERATION: This position is open to the grades of: E6 to E7. Individual selected will receive an AGR Tour with the Louisiana Army National Guard. In order to be considered for this position's applicants must meet minimum qualifications as outlined on this announcement.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING: All documents will be uploaded to FTSMCS no later than 2300 as one PDF in the order listed on the checklist. If any of the required documents are not reasonably available to you, a brief letter will be submitted citing the documents missing with a short explanation necessary to certify the soldier as eligible. Failure to do so may result in a finding of ineligibility and may cause the applicant to lose consideration for this position by the hiring agency.

1. AGR APPLICATION

MINIMUM APPOINTMENT REQUIREMENTS:

All enlisted jobs will be staffed in accordance with LAARNG AGR Enlisted Career Management Policy dated 1 December 2023.

1. All E7 Applicants - Must have held a previous AGR duty assignment as a DRU or BN Assistant Operations NCO, or Unit Readiness NCO, or RTI SR Facilitator, or SR REC & RET NCO, or held an Excepted Position IAW paragraph j of this policy.
2. All E6 Applicants - Must have held a previous duty assignment as a Supply Sergeant and any of the following AGR Duty Assignments but not limited to: Detachment Readiness NCO, Admin NCO, MRNCO, R&R NCO, SGL, Assistant PSNCO or CBRN NCO
3. All E6 Applicants – Must be on the current EPS OML.
4. Must meet Suitability Criteria IAW AR 600-78.

ADDITIONAL JOB INFORMATION:

- All exception to Policy request must be processed through Chain of Command and submitted with your AGR application to the AGR Branch regardless of concurrence.
- Promotion contingent on control grade availability.
- LAARNG promotion policies apply together with maximum grade limitations for the position as designated by NGB and appropriate MTOE/TDA.
- Acceptance to a position of higher grade, SM will incur a service obligation in accordance with AR 600-8-19 upon promotion.
- Acceptance of tour is subject to personal interview, ACFT, and Army body fat standards upon notification of time and place. Necessary travel is at applicant's own expense.
- Applicant must hold a SECRET security Clearance.
- Direct combat probability code applies: No, male or female may apply
- Deployed Soldiers are encouraged to apply for jobs. Deployment will not be held against the Soldier during the hiring process.

BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:

Responsible for ALL RSP detachment duties. The selectee receives and integrates newly assessed Soldiers into the RSP. Conducts monthly shipper packet reviews ensuring Soldiers are administratively prepared to ship to IET. Responsible for all pay and personnel transactions, attendance reports, and DA Form 1379. Supervises or administers the Occupational Physical Assessment Test (OPAT). Update and maintain VULCAN RSP site data as required. Initiate Line of Duty if Soldiers are injured during RSP Drill. Processes and submits all IET completion documents related to MOS award or SRIP. Recognizes RSP Soldiers for IET achievement. Maintain Soldier rosters by phase. Maintain upcoming shipper roster. Coordinate Battle Hand-Off from RSP to their unit of assignment. Identify and assist with AWOL recovery. Plans, coordinates and executes training schedules, DRM, AAR's. Coordinate all administrative and logistical actions within the RSP. Act as LNO to ISG or Co Commander. Act as RSP Cadre during IADT weekends. Counsel, advice, and mentor Soldiers regarding all aspects of training and success as members of the ARNG. Performs other duties as assigned.

Must work a non-compressed work week (5 days a week).
